Dear County Sheriff and County Clerk:

Beginning in **February 2020**, Department of Revenue Bureau of Equalization staff appraisers will be working throughout our 15-county district as part of an assessment review. The Department appraisers will be traveling throughout each county viewing selected real estate parcels that sold during 2019.

Reviewing the sales involves viewing the land and improvements from the road, taking pictures, and in some cases, talking with the buyers and sellers involved in each real estate transaction. Information gathered will aid the Department in identifying the market value of Agricultural, Undeveloped, Forest, and Ag Site Land in the county. This work is expected to be completed by **April 30, 2020**.

Department of Revenue employees will have a Department-issued photo ID with them at all times. The following staff appraisers will be performing reviews: Dean Powers, James Monette, Charles Paskey, Brenda Carus and Katie Norton. Personal vehicle information is listed below:
